- Know who is in your group.
- Keep the group together and stay with the students at all times. **You are responsible for the behavior of the students you are chaperoning.**

WHAT ARE THE MISSIONS BEHAVIOR GUIDELINES?

- Stay with your group. Students and adult chaperons must stay with their group at all times-inside or outside the Mission, Museum and in the Gift Shop.
- Be courteous and respectful of all visitors. Talk quietly and walk through the Mission and grounds.
- Be respectful of the Mission exhibits and buildings. Use books or clipboards to write against, instead of walls, windows or exhibits. Stay off of all walls, pillars and railings.
