# REQUIREMENTS FOR BAPTIZING AT OLD MISSION SAN JUAN BAUTISTA

#### **FOR PARENTS:**

1) Assistance at a pre-baptism instruction class. (Attendance within 24 months with a certificate of completion will be acceptable.) The fee for these classes are not included in the baptism stipend.

### \*ONLINE CLASSES ARE NOT ACCEPTABLE

- 2) Completed Baptism Inquiry Form
- 3) A Copy of the child's birth certificate
- 4) Stipend for Group Baptism: **\$100** for one Child and **\$150** 2 or more children with in the principal family.

 First, Second, and Third Saturday of the month are reserved for Spanish Group Baptisms at 10am

The Last Saturday of the month is reserved for English Group Baptism at 10am

- 5) Private Baptisms are upon special arrangement and are \$300 per child. Do to a high request. In the event of cancelation, only half of the amount will be reimburse.
- 6) Parents are to select one or two Catholics in good standing with the Catholic Church to serve as the child's Godparent(s). Only a **Catholic** person can be a Godparent sponsoring a child into the Catholic church. A Godparent must meet the following criteria (per Cannon Law):

## **FOR ALL GODPARENTS:**

a) Must be over the age of 16,

b) In good standing with the Catholic Church

- c) If married, must be married through the Catholic Church
  - \*If the parents cannot designate more than one Catholic for this important role, then one **non-Catholic** who is baptized and belongs to a **non Catholic** Christian denomination can be a "Christian Witness". If there will be a Christian Witness, there must also be a qualified Catholic Godparent. Christian Witnesses also need to provide proof of baptism, a letter from their pastor stating that they are in good standing in their church, and must attend the Catholic pre-baptism class.
- 1. We need: A certificate or letter stating that you have attended the pre-baptism class. (May attend with the parents in their parish.)

2. **Christian Witnesses** need to provide the following:

a) A Letter from your pastor stating that you are in good standing in your church;

b) Proof of pre-baptism class attendance at a Catholic Church.
